Structure Fire



On Sunday, March 24 at approximately 1 p.m., the Lombard Fire Department responded to a report of a structure fire on the 400 block of South Grace Street in Lombard. Crews arrived on scene and confirmed a fire in the detached garage of a single family home. Crews rapidly deployed hose lines to combat the fire while other crews conducted a thorough search for any extension to the home and neighboring residences. The fire was declared under control within ten minutes of arrival. There were no injuries to residents or firefighters. The Lombard Fire Investigations Unit is currently investigating the cause of the fire.

The Fire Department was assisted by the Elmhurst and Villa Park Fire Departments, as well as the Addison and York Center Fire Protection Districts. The Lombard Police Department assisted with traffic and crowd control.
