**Butterfield Yorktown Proposed TIF District SUBJECT:** 

Village staff will be updating the ECDC regularly on the proposed Butterfield Yorktown TIF District. Staff, legal counsel, and our consultant are progressing with our tasks and are on schedule. The draft Redevelopment Plan and Project is complete and was announced at the Village Board on June 15, 2017. Please refer to the attached timeline for action items. Information is available online at http://www.villageoflombard.org/5328/Butterfield-Yorktown-TIF.

The Redevelopment Plan and Project defines possible expenditures and a possible budget. The Village is under no obligation to spend the money. The TIF Plan contains a maximum budget of how much increment we may collect and how it may be spent.

In the proposed TIF District, staff notes that Northern Baptist Seminary is for sale and they are working through a Request for Proposals (RFP) process. Greystar has closed on the Yorktown property and has permits under review for multi-family residential. Nothing is immediately pending on the other sites.
