SUBJECT: Amending Title 11, Chapter 112, Section 112.24(B)

Service of Alcoholic Beverages in an Outdoor Seating/Service Area

Village Code Title 11, Chapter 112, Sections 112.24(A) through (C) outline additional conditions placed on liquor licensees. Examples of these conditions include not serving alcohol to any intoxicated person, that an individual may not leave the "licensed premises" with alcoholic liquor in his/her possession, that a parking area is not consider part of the licensed premises, and that all licensees maintain a valid State liquor license.

In that regard, Section 112.24(B) of Village Code is being amended to add language relative to outdoor seating and service areas located on private property. The proposed ordinance clarifies that the consumption of alcoholic beverages on the "licensed premises" would extend to any outdoor seating and service area which has either been approved by the granting of a conditional use or constitutes an "Outdoor Café" (as defined in the Zoning Ordinance) and is located in the B5 or B5A Zoning District.

Staff met with Village Counsel who drafted the attached ordinance. The proposed amendments are consistent with how the Code has been previously interpreted and applied to existing uses with outdoor seating areas.

Staff is requesting a waiver of first reading.

ORDINANCE NO. _____

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING TITLE XI, CHAPTER 112, SECTION 112.24(B) OF THE LOMBARD VILLAGE CODE IN REGARD TO ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGES AND OUTDOOR SEATING AREAS

BE IT ORDAINED by the President and Board of Trustees of the Village of Lombard, DuPage County, Illinois, as follows:

SECTION 1: That Title XI, Chapter 112, Section 112.24(B) of the Lombard Village Code is amended by adding the following language to the end thereof:

"For purposes of this subsection, an outdoor seating and service area on private property that: (1) is approved pursuant to the granting of a conditional use therefor; or (2) is an "Outdoor Café," as defined in Section 155.802 of this Code, and is located in either the B5 Central Business District or B5A Downtown Perimeter District; shall be considered part of the licensed premises for a business that has been issued a liquor license for the consumption of alcoholic beverages on the licensed premises."

SECTION 2: That this Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage, approval and publication in pamphlet form, as provided by law.
