# **Existing Policies**


- No present regulations directly addressing Board, employee, or committee member conduct on social media
- Existing policies, while not directly related to social media, would prohibit certain online conduct:
  - Political conduct on Village time and equipment prohibited
  - First responder prohibits conduct unbecoming an officer

- Guidance language for social media conduct POLICY
  - Recommendations/guidance for conduct
  - Focus of this presentation
- Enforceable regulations HR MANUAL
  - Clear enforceable directives on conduct
- Organizational social media policies POLICY
  - Standards and practices for organizational use of social media






