## Request for removal of 5 minute Parking- 12 S. Park Ave.

I received an email from an adjacent business owner in District 1 requesting the removal of the 5 minute parking sign from the former Park Avenue Cleaners (12 S. Park Ave.) which is no longer in existence. The sign was in place for customers of the former Park Avenue Cleaner and is no longer necessary.

WHEREAS, the President and Board of Trustees of the Village of Lombard have heretofore passed and approved Ordinance 1186, An Ordinance Regulating Traffic in the Village of Lombard (hereinafter the Lombard Traffic Code); and

WHEREAS, the President and Board of Trustees of the Village of Lombard find that the Lombard Traffic Code has been amended from time to time; and

WHEREAS, the Transportation and Safety Committee has reviewed the appropriate traffic studies and recommends certain changes to the Lombard Traffic Code; and

WHEREAS, the Corporate Authorities of the Village of Lombard concur in the recommendation of the Transportation and Safety Committee.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE PRESIDENT AND BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE VILLAGE OF LOMBARD, DU PAGE COUNTY, ILLINOIS, as follows:

Section 1: That Schedule X (PARKING TIME LIMITED ON CERTAIN STREETS) of the Lombard Traffic Code (Ordinance 1186) is amended to reflect the removal of the following:

"(M) In accordance with Section 10-13-10, and when signs are erected giving notice thereof, no person shall park a vehicle for a period of time exceeding 5 minutes, from 7:00 a.m. to 7:00 p.m., Monday through Saturday, at any of the following locations: Park Avenue, west side, 8<sup>th</sup> parking stall south of St. Charles Road."
