ORDINANCE NO. 7641

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING TITLE XI, CHAPTER 112, SECTION 112.16 OF THE LOMBARD VILLAGE CODE IN REGARD TO THE LICENSING PERIODS FOR LIQUOR LICENSES

BE IT ORDAINED by the President and Board of Trustees of the Village of Lombard, DuPage County, Illinois, as follows:

SECTION 1: That Title XI, Chapter 112, Section 112.16 of the Lombard Village Code is amended by revising the first sentence thereof to read in its entirety as follows:

"Each license (with the exception of Classes "J", "P", "Q-I" and "Q-II") shall be issued for six (6) months only, and shall terminate on the next following June 30th or December 31st after its issuance, whichever shall occur first."

SECTION 2: That, in light of the Lombard Village Code amendment provided for in Section 1 above, all liquor licenses that were issued for the December 1, 2018 through May 31, 2019 licensing period shall be extended through June 30, 2019, without need for the payment of any additional license fee.

SECTION 3: That this Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage, approval and publication in pamphlet form, as provided by law.
