Bid specifications were sent to the Master Intergovernmental Cooperative Purchasing Agreement (MICPA) with U.S. Communities Government Purchasing Alliance. Currently 497 communities in Illinois are participating in U.S. Communities Government Purchasing Alliance. The U.S. Communities Government Purchasing Alliance is a program that affords member communities an opportunity to participate in a program whereby a service or commodity is publically bid by a Lead Agency and the results of that competitive solicitation is available to all 90,000 public agencies. The Village used the same process for roofing projects on the Police Department, Village Hall and Public Works buildings. Slaten Construction submitted the winning bid to a US Communities contract holder for Roofing/ Window supplies and fixtures. The bid results are as follows:

Staff recommends approving the Village Hall and Fire Station 45 Window replacement Project contract with Slaten Construction in an amount not to exceed \$543,200. The Budgeted amount for this project is \$550,000.00


- 1. window tint meeting the following code requirements:
 - a. Dupage County is in Climate Zone 5
 - b. The U-Factor is to be .38 or less for fixed fenestration
 - c. The U-Factor is to be .45 or less for operable fenestration
 - d. The U-Factor is to be .77 or less for Entrance Doors
 - e. SHGC (solar heat gain coefficient) .40 facing South, East, or West and .53 facing North
 - f. Meet the testing requirements of the 2015 International Building Code section 1710.5 for exterior windows
 - g. Be labeled with a NFRC (National Fenestration Rating Council) sticker/tag
 - h. All windows to have a tint to match the existing and as approved by the customer
 - i. All window frames to match existing and as approved by the customer




