SUBJECT: Title XI, Chapter 112, Sections 112.12(A), 112.13(A), and 112.4(A) of the Lombard Village Code – Alcoholic Beverages

Attached is an ordinance amending the Lombard Village Code Alcoholic Beverages Sections 112.12(A), 112.13(A), and 112.4(A), relative to the Liquor License Class “E-VG”.

Current

"Class "E-VG" Alcoholic beverages served as an adjunct to a sports and fitness center, or a recreational center not covered by a Class "M" or Class "R" liquor license, for consumption on the premises only, in a dedicated alcoholic beverages service area of no less than 1,800 square feet in area; no package sales allowed. Food shall be available to patrons in the dedicated alcoholic beverages service area, whether from on-site food options or from delivery by off-site vendors; however, a full-service kitchen shall not be required. The operation of video gaming terminals on the licensed premises shall be allowed, so long as video gaming is not prohibited within the Village, provided the establishment has been issued a video gaming license by the Illinois Gaming Board in accordance with the provisions of the Illinois Video Gaming Act, and further provided the establishment shall comply with all the provisions of Chapter 112 of the Village Code, the Illinois Video Gaming Act, and all rules, regulations and restrictions imposed by the Illinois Gaming Board.

After the decrease in the number of available Class “E-VG” licenses to “0”, at the April 17, 2025, Board of Trustees meeting, and further review with staff and the Village Attorney, it is recommended to amend the Lombard Village Code and remove the Class “E-VG”, in its entirety.

Staff is requesting a waiver of first reading to reflect the amendments to the said Alcoholic Beverage sections of the Lombard Village Code.

**AN ORDINANCE AMENDING VARIOUS SECTIONS OF TITLE XI,
CHAPTER 112 OF THE LOMBARD VILLAGE CODE
IN REGARD TO CLASS “E-VG” LIQUOR LICENSES**

BE IT ORDAINED by the President and Board of Trustees of the Village of Lombard, DuPage County, Illinois, as follows:

SECTION 1: That Title XI, Chapter 112, Article II, Section 112.12(A) of the Lombard Village Code, is hereby amended by removing the Class “E-VG” liquor license classification, which appears after the Class “EE” liquor license classification and before the Class “F” liquor license classification. Removal of the description of the Class “E-VG” liquor license from Section 112.12(A) reflects that there is no longer a Class “E-VG” liquor license classification.

SECTION 2: That Title XI, Chapter 112, Article II, Section 112.13(A) of the Lombard Village Code, is hereby amended by removing the row of the Availability Table that refers to Class “E-VG” liquor licenses, which appears below the row for Class “EE” liquor licenses and above the row for Class “F” liquor licenses. Removal of the Class “E-VG” liquor license from the Availability Table in Section 112.13(A) reflects that there is no longer a Class “E-VG” liquor license classification.

SECTION 3: That Title XI, Chapter 112, Article II, Section 112.14(A) of the Lombard Village Code, is hereby amended by removing the row to the Fees Table that refers to Class “E-VG” liquor licenses, which appears below the row for Class “EE” liquor licenses and above the row for Class “FF” liquor licenses. Removal of the Class “E-VG”

liquor license from the Fees Table in Section 112.14(A) reflects that there is no longer a Class "E-VG" liquor license classification.

SECTION 4: That this Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage, approval and publication in pamphlet form, as provided by law.
