SUBJECT: Title XI, Chapter 112, Section 112.18(B) of the Village Code – Alcoholic Beverages
Lombard Historical Society – Food Truck Social

The Lombard Historical Society (LHS) submitted a request to host a Food Truck Social event, Saturday, September 5, 2026. This type of special event is the fifth with the previous approvals pursuant to the Village Code for a Class J liquor license application as a not-for-profit.

The Historical Society is seeking to hold the event within the parking lot adjacent to the organization, 23 W. Maple Street, with a beer station (garden) in an area that will be fenced off to ensure that alcohol remains within the designated space for the event. The event is scheduled to take place between the hours of 4:00 p.m. and 9:00 p.m.

LHS has hosted several special events in the past with Class “J” liquor licenses. Past approvals were issued administratively given that alcohol consumption had been limited to parking areas previously under the ownership of the Helen Plum Library, not the Village of Lombard. Subsequently, the Village of Lombard has acquired the parking lot and LHS has expanded and moved their area of consumption to portions of the facility under Village ownership.

The event will feature a variety of food trucks, live music, and family-friendly activities. The Lombard Historical Society is partnering with Brew Avenue Events to coordinate the food trucks and manage the beer station, being responsible for checking guests’ IDs and providing wristbands to attendees. LHS will purchase the beer in advance and will have Basset certified staff and volunteers onsite that will closely monitor the event to ensure the consumption of alcohol will remain on the premises.

The current request is solely for the issuance of the temporary event liquor license. Final approvals for special event permitting, which would include security, permitting, traffic, emergency planning, and other logistics, would be under separate application to the Village and have yet to be approved. Accordingly, given that the approval requested here relates solely to the liquor license, the event will remain subject to application and final approval of all other necessary special event processes. Applicants are aware of and understand these conditions.

ACTION REQUESTED

Please place this item on August 20, 2026, Village Board agenda for approval of an amendment to Section 112.18(B) of the Lombard Village Code to provide for the 2026 Food Truck Social event. A waiver of first reading is also requested.

ORDINANCE NO.

**AN ORDINANCE AMENDING TITLE XI, CHAPTER 112, SECTION 112.18(B)
OF THE LOMBARD VILLAGE CODE IN REGARD TO ALCOHOLIC
BEVERAGES, PROVIDING FOR THE SALE AND CONSUMPTION OF
ALCOHOL IN CONNECTION WITH A TEMPORARY EVENT
LOCATED ON VILLAGE-OWNED PROPERTY**

BE IT ORDAINED by the President and Board of Trustees of the Village of Lombard, DuPage County, Illinois, as follows:

SECTION 1: That Title XI, Chapter 112, Section 112.18(B) of the Lombard Village Code is hereby amended by adding a new subsection (6) thereto, effective upon the adoption of this Ordinance through 9:00 p.m. on Saturday, September 5, 2026, which shall read in its entirety, as follows:

“(6) That in association with a Food Truck Social event to be sponsored by the Lombard Historical Society, a not-for-profit organization, the Lombard Historical Society shall be eligible for a Class “J” liquor license for the sole purpose of selling beer, cider, mead, and seltzers for consumption on the licensed premises only, on Saturday, September 5, 2026, from 4:00 p.m. to 9:00 p.m., in a designated and secured area, approved by the Village pursuant to the issuance of a temporary event permit under Chapter 110 of the Village Code. The liquor license to be issued under this subsection (6) may be issued by the Local Liquor Commissioner upon proper application to the Village, and satisfaction of all applicable requirements and conditions by the licensee. No liquor license shall be issued under this subsection (6) until such time as the licensee obtains the necessary temporary event permit under Chapter 110 of the Village Code, and complies with all requirements and conditions thereof, including, without limitation, the insurance, bond and indemnification requirements of Chapter 110 for temporary events. Video gaming, as provided for under the Illinois Video Gaming Act, shall not be allowed on the licensed premises.”

SECTION 2: That, effective at 9:00 p.m. on Saturday, September 5, 2026, Title XI, Chapter 112, Section 112.18(B)(6) of the Lombard Village Code, as set forth in Section 1 above, is hereby repealed, without need for any further action by the President and Board of Trustees.

SECTION 3: This ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage and approval as provided by law.
