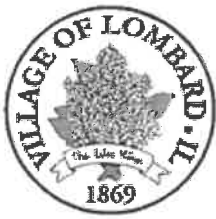

Nine (9) potential bidders purchased plans for the referenced project. Nine (9) bids were received and opened at 9:00 A.M. on April 2, 2020. The bid results, in order of lowest to highest, are listed below:

Per the contract specifications, the Village had sixty (60) days to award the contract from the date of the bid opening. The Village did not take action to award the contract within the sixty (60) day timeframe. As such, staff recommends that the Village reject the bids received at the April 2, 2020 bid opening, waive the competitive bidding process and award a contract to Globe Construction in the amount of \$720,615.40. Globe Construction has agreed to extend and honor their bid beyond the sixty (60) day period that was included in the specifications for the 2020 Concrete Rehabilitation Project.

CONTRACT DOCUMENT NUMBER RM PROG 49

This agreement is made this 12th day of May, 2020, between and shall be binding upon the Village of Lombard, an Illinois municipal corporation (hereinafter referred to as the "Village") and Globe Construction, Inc. (hereinafter referred to as the "Contractor") and their respective successors.

Witnessed, that in consideration of the mutual promises of the parties delineated in the Contract Documents, the Contractor agrees to perform the services and the Village agrees to pay for the following services as set forth in the Contract Documents:

FY 2020 CONCRETE REHABILITATION

1. This contract shall embrace and include all of the applicable Contract Documents listed below as if attached hereto or repeated herein:
 - a. Contract Document Number RM PROG 49 FY 2020 CONCRETE REHABILITATION, consisting of the following:
 - i) Cover Sheet
 - ii) Table of Contents
 - iii) Notice to Bidders on Contract Document Number RM PROG 49 Legal Notice
 - iv) General Provisions
 - v) Special Provisions
 - vi) Plans and Specifications
 - b. The Contractor's Bid Proposal Dated: April 2, 2020
 - c. Required Performance and Payment Bonds and Certificate(s) of Insurance
 - d. Executed Bidder's Certification Form.
2. The Village agrees to pay, and the Contractor agrees to accept as full payment the amount as shown on the Contractor's Bid Proposal, which is made a part hereof, subject to such additions and deletions as agreed

to by the parties hereto.

3. The Contractor shall commence work under this Contract upon written Notice to Proceed from the Village and shall complete work under this contract on or before August 21, 2020. Time is of the essence in regard to this Contract, and the Contractor agrees to achieve completion within the time permitted by all proper and appropriate means including working overtime without additional compensation.
4. Pursuant to the provisions of Section 5 of the Mechanics' Lien Act of Illinois, prior to making any payment to the Contractor under this Contract, the Village demands that the Contractor furnish a written statement of the names of all parties furnishing labor and/or materials under this Contract and the amounts due or to become due each. This statement must be made under oath or be verified by affidavit. The Village shall not issue final payment nor shall any retained percentage become due until releases and waivers of lien have been supplied as the Village designates.
5. This Contract represents the entire agreement between the parties and may not be modified without the written approval of both parties.

IN WITNESS WHEREOF, the Village of Lombard, Illinois, and the Contractor have each hereunto caused this Contract to be executed by their respective duly authorized representatives this 12th day of May, 2020.

CONTRACT BOND

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS, that we Globe Construction, Inc., a company organized under the laws of the State of IL and licensed to do business in the State of Illinois as Principal and Washington International Insurance Company, a corporation organized and existing under the laws of the State of NH, with authority to do business in the State of Illinois, as Surety, are now held and firmly bound unto the Village of Lombard, State of Illinois in the penal sum of Seven Hundred Twenty Thousand Six Hundred Fifteen Dollars and 40 Cents dollars (\$ 720,615.40) lawful money of the United States, well and truly to be paid unto said Village for the payment of which we bind ourselves, our successors and assigns, jointly, severally, and firmly by these presents.
