WHEREAS, the Departments of Public Works and Community Development of the Village of Lombard have certified the completion of the public sanitary sewer at 165 & 169 N. West Road (165-169 N. West Road Sanitary Main Extension) and has recommended that said improvements be accepted; and

SECTION 2: That the on-site sanitary sewer, water service, and storm sewer are to remain the responsibility of the property owner.
