SUBJECT: Title XI, Chapter 118, Section 118.10 Solicitation for Contributions on a Highway

Attached is an ordinance repealing Title XI, Chapter 118, Section 118.10 of the Lombard Village Code relative to Peddlers and Solicitors Soliciting for Contributions on a Highway.

This amendment is proposed resultant to a recent Federal Court ruling in which the Court found a portion of the Illinois Vehicle Code relating to Rules of the Road unconstitutional. The section of the Vehicular Code at issue, 625 ILCS 5/11-1006(c), provides, in pertinent part:

No person shall stand on a highway for the purpose of soliciting contributions from the occupant of any vehicle except within a municipality when expressly permitted by municipal ordinance. The local municipality, city, village, or other local governmental entity in which the solicitation takes place shall determine by ordinance where and when solicitations may take place based on the safety of the solicitors and the safety of motorists. The decision shall also take into account the orderly flow of traffic and may not allow interference with the operation of official traffic control devices.

In the case in question, the Court concluded as a matter of law, that the section above is a "contentbased restriction on the freedom of speech that is not justified by any compelling interest and that the provision violates the First Amendment and is unconstitutional on its face under clearly established law." (No. 19-cv-5604)

Accordingly, the portion of the Lombard Village Code relating to Peddlers and Solicitors and referencing 625 ILCS 5/11-1006 is proposed to be deleted by the attached ordinance. Section 118.10 provided that "soliciting for contributions (fund soliciting) from the occupants of motor vehicles, while standing on a highway" should only be permitted under certain conditions, and is proposed to be deleted.
