

## ORDINANCE NO. 4979

## AN ORDINANCE AMENDING TITLE 7, CHAPTER 72, SECTION 72.04 (B) OF THE LOMBARD VILLAGE CODE IN REGARD TO IMMOBILIZATION OF MOTOR VEHICLES

**Be It Ordained** by the President and Board of Trustees of the Village of Lombard, DuPage County, Illinois as follows:

Section 1: That Title 7, Chapter 72, Section 72.04 (B)(3) is hereby amended to read in its entirety as follows:

"(3) Deposit collateral in the amount of the number of outstanding complaints listed in the notice of eligibility for immobilization times fifteen dollars (\$15.00), but not to exceed five hundred dollars \$500.00), and execute an agreement to present copies of appearances filed with the clerk of the Circuit Court of DuPage County on all outstanding complaints specified in the notice of eligibility for immobilization within twenty-one (21) days from the date of the agreement. Such collateral shall be returned upon receipt of copies of the appearances, but shall be forfeited if the owner does not present such copies and the forfeited collateral may not be used to satisfy any unpaid fees or penalties. Upon forfeiture of collateral, the motor vehicle involved shall again be subject to immediate immobilization and no further deposit of collateral as described in this subsection shall again be allowed as a method of release; or"

Section 2: That Title 7, Chapter 72, Section 72.04 (B) hereby is amended by adding subsection (4) to read in its entirety:

"(4) Pay fifteen dollars (\$15.00) per outstanding complaint and sign an installment agreement to pay the remainder of the amount owed over a period of time. Each payment made under the installment agreement will be applied to the total amount due and no one (1) or more outstanding complaint(s) shall be considered paid until the entire amount due for all outstanding complaints is paid. If payments are not made as required in the installment agreement, the agreement shall become void, the motor vehicle shall be subject to reimmobilization and the original amount due (less any amount paid) plus additional charges for re-immobilization shall become due. No further option under this subsection (B) (4) shall be available; and"

Section 3: That this Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage
