RE: Awarding Rights-of-way Tree Pruning Contract

On October 10th, 2024, the Village of Lombard advertised for bids for the Village contract **RM PROG 55**, *Rights-of-Way Tree Pruning and Demand Pruning/Cabling*. Bid documents were sent to 11 companies. The bid opening was held on October 25th, 2024 with four (4) bids being received. The Bid Tabulation sheet is attached.

Advanced Landscaping LLC submitted the lowest bid but failed to meet the requirements for qualified bidders. Of the three references they provided, only one involved a municipal tree pruning project in NE Illinois. That project was also substantially different from the work expected for this contract. Additionally, they do not have an ISA Certified Arborist on staff as required by the bid specifications. Having an ISA Certified Arborist supervise the crews is imperative to the proper completion of the work.

D Ryan Tree and Landscape LLC submitted the second lowest bid of \$83,157.00 which is \$1,843.00 below what has been budgeted for fiscal year 2025 for rights-of-way tree pruning. The bid documents allow the Village to adjust quantities to fit within budget. The FY25 budget contains \$85,000.00 from the Construction fund RM Program 57 for rights-of-way tree pruning purposes. D Ryan Tree and Landscape Service LLC is the current contract holder, and their work has been mostly acceptable. They have been responsive for calls for corrective action when needed.

Staff recommends awarding the contract to *D Ryan Tree and Landscape LLC* for an amount not to exceed \$84,625.00 for parkway tree pruning purposes. Please present this item to the Board of Trustees at the November 7th, 2024 meeting for their approval. This is a one-year contract with two one-year renewal options upon mutual agreement.

Pursuant to the provisions of Section 5 of the Mechanics' Lien Act of Illinois, prior to making any payment on this contract the Village demands that the Contractor furnish a written statement of the names of all parties furnishing labor and/or materials under this Contract and the amounts due or to become due on each. This statement must be made under oath or be verified by affidavit. Final payment shall not be issued by the Village nor shall any retained percentage become due until releases and waivers of lien have been supplied as the Village designates.
- 7. In executing this Contract, Contractor agrees that it has examined the site of the work and the conditions existing therein, has examined the Contract Documents and taken and compared field measurements and conditions with those Documents.
