**AN ORDINANCE AMENDING TITLE III, CHAPTER 31,
ARTICLE VI OF THE LOMBARD VILLAGE CODE
IN REGARD TO FIREFIGHTER RESIDENCY REQUIREMENTS**

BE IT ORDAINED by the President and Board of Trustees of the Village of Lombard, DuPage County, Illinois, as follows:

SECTION 1: That Title III, Chapter 31, Article VI, Section 31.65(E) of the Lombard Village Code, is hereby amended to read in its entirety as follows:

“(E) Notwithstanding subsection (D) above, except as provided in subsection (A) above, any member of the Fire Department may, in addition to residing anywhere in Illinois, reside in Indiana or Wisconsin, but must be reasonably accessible to the village so that said member is able to properly and adequately carry out his or her job duties or functions.”

SECTION 2: All ordinances, or parts of ordinances, in conflict with the provisions of this Ordinance, to the extent of such conflict, are repealed.

SECTION 3: That this Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage, approval and publication in pamphlet form, as provided by law.
