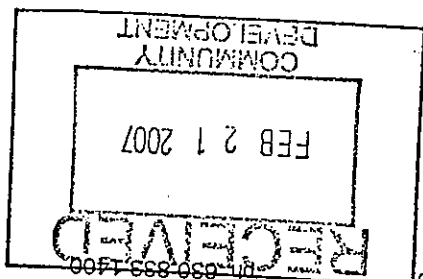

WHEREAS, the Co-Op Nursery provides a nurturing and play-enriched environment for young children that fosters a joy of learning and respectful interaction among peers while promoting a cooperative partnership between home and school; and

WHEREAS, the Co-Op currently offers the following classes:
Parent/Toddler Class for children 15 months to 2 1/2 years old with a parent;
Parents' Day Out on Thursdays from 9:30 a.m. to 2:00 p.m. for children 15 months to 5 years old;
2 Day Class for 2 1/2 - 3 1/2 year olds;
Morning and Afternoon 3-Day Preschool Classes for children 3 years old and young 4 year olds who are not eligible to go to Kindergarten the next year; and Morning and Afternoon 3 Day Pre-Kindergarten classes for children who are eligible to go to Kindergarten the following year

WHEREAS, the Co-op Nursery will be commemorating it's 50 years with a celebration on April 29th from 2-4 p.m. at the school;

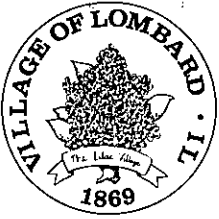
WHEREAS, youth-serving prevention programs offer positive alternatives for young people and encourage youth to develop strong ties to their community and
