Subject: Waiver of Bids - 2025 Emergency Water & Sewer Repairs

John Neri Construction Company

Background

The Village's Trenching and Excavation Policy states that Village crews will not enter trenches or excavations deeper than ten feet. Digs that are of an emergency nature or too deep for the Village equipment to safely excavate are generally completed by a contractor. John Neri Construction Company of Addison, IL, has worked for the Village in the past, responding in an expedient manner, and has always performed satisfactorily. The number of repairs performed by the contractor varies from year to year depending on need.

Funds for sewer repairs are budgeted in the Water and Sewer Capital Reserve Fund under Sewer Maintenance & Improvements RM PROG 10 with funds for water repairs budgeted in the Water and Sewer Capital Reserve Fund under Water Maintenance & Improvements RM PROG 32. These types of repairs are based on a time and material basis using a standard IDOT format. Labor rates are based on respective negotiated union contracts in the construction trade and are consistent across local contractors.

Generally, the Utilities Group spends an average of \$50,000 -\$60,000 annually (excluding 2023 and 2025) on these types of repairs and will vary depending on emergency repairs needed. The chart below is the expenditures for these emergency repairs.

2025 Includes two invoices of \$21,325.00 (an RFP was issued for this repair) and \$7,401.73 (emergency sewer collapse repair) that have not yet been paid out. John Neri Construction Company has been the Village's emergency repair contractor for several years and continues to provide fast reliable response to repair requests and does

excellent work. They also have been awarded numerous Water and Sewer Capital Improvement projects over the years and have a long-standing relationship with the Village.

Recommendations

Please present this request for a waiver of bids and award in the amount of \$28,726.73 to John Neri Construction Company of Addison, IL, for emergency sewer repairs for approval by the Board of Trustees at their December 4, 2025 meeting.
