Subject: FY26 Vehicle Replacement, Ford F-150 Responder

The FY 2026 vehicle reserve schedule includes replacement of a 2018 Ford Expedition in the Fire Rescue Fleet. This vehicle is utilized by the shift Battalion Chief (vehicle FR3). This vehicle is utilized to respond to emergency calls and as a command post during emergency operations. In addition to those roles, over recent years it has also been utilized to store and transport one off speciality tools and equipment for department operations. These roles, especially housing more equipment, have been difficult to support with the Ford Expedition SUV platform. Fire Department staff have identified the Ford F-150 Responder as a vehicle better suited for their current needs as a replacement vehicle. The Ford F-150 Responder is available for purchase through the Suburban Purchasing Cooperative (SPC) contract #228 from Currie Motors of Frankfort (IL). The SPC contact price for the F-150 Responder is \$48,390. This vehicle will need to be upfit with equipment specified by the Fire Department. There will be a forthcoming agenda item for consideration of this equipment purchase through a separate vendor which is estimated at \$25,000. Fleet Services will perform the upfit on this vehicle.

Staff recommends the Board of Trustees waive the competitive bidding process and award a contract to Currie Motors of Frankfort (IL) in the amount of \$48,390 for one new Ford F-150 responder.
