Butterfield Rd Water Main Evaluation & Rehabilitation

Enclosed is proposed Change Order #1 for the Butterfield Rd Water Main Evaluation & Rehabilitation Project. The change order for a net increase of \$171,499.81 is for additional costs the following:

- 1. Performance bond requirement- \$6,822.90
- 2. Exploratory dig for difficult water main location \$3,023.68
- 3. Downtime for excessive water flow in water main shut down \$3,151.49
- 4. Removal of un-anticipated concrete thrust block and 4" x 4" steel posts \$3,102.47
- 5. \$57,150 for 254 LF of 12" CIPP Water Main Lining
- 6. \$35,000 for one Hydrant Installation (New)
- 7. \$120,000 for three additional Lining Access Pits
- 8. \$26,802 for 4,467 SF of additional Parkway Restoration Dirt/Seed
- 9. \$4,647.25 for Stainless Steel Tapping Sleeves
- 10. \$3,950.41 for Guard Rail Removal/Replacement
- 11. \$2,101.53 for Erosion Control Blanket
- 12. (\$56,000) for reduction of 320 LF of 10" Water Main Lining
- 13. (\$28,000) for reduction of one Hydrant Removal/New Installation
- 14. (\$15,000) for reduction of one 60" Valve Vault

The performance bond is a requirement by statute and was on oversite in the RFP process by both parties. The additional work of items two through four were discovered during the regular excavation and locating work for the project and are unforeseen additions.

The additional and reduction of quantities for the 12" and 10" water main lining items were due to existing field conditions verified during construction. The additional new hydrant installation replaced the hydrant removal/new installation item due to field conditions that would not allow the hydrant to be placed back in the same position, so it

needed to be relocated. There additional lining access pits were added above the estimated quantity that was in the original RFP and proposal due to field conditions found during construction. Three additional pits were required due to a 45-degree bend in the water main that could not be lined through that caused the length between proposed pits to be too long for the lining process, as well as an additional water main crossing found during construction not on Village maps. Additional quantities for parkway restoration were due to the additional access lining pits and hydrant relocation as well as erosion control due to the slope of the right of way. Stainless steel tapping sleeves were required due to the existing Tee's that were unusable for reinstallation in the lining pits for the water main crossings. Finally the guard rail was not anticipated to be needed to be removed for access pits but was for the safety and stability of the access pits.

The original contract was awarded for a contract amount of \$740,800.00 with Change Order #1 increasing the contract in the amount of \$171,499.81 will increase the total contract to \$912,299.81 and will be the final change order.

Recommendation

Staff recommends for an approval of Change Order #1 in the amount of \$171,499.81 for a total contract amount of \$912,299.81.

RESOLUTION R_

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING A CHANGE ORDER INVOLVING AN INCREASE/DECREASE IN THE DOLLAR AMOUNT OF THE CONTRACT OF \$10,000 OR MORE AND/OR EXTENDING/ SHORTENING THE TIME IN WHICH THE CONTRACT IS TO BE COMPLETED BY THIRTY (30) DAYS OR MORE

WHEREAS, pursuant to Illinois Compiled Statutes, Chapter 720, Section 5/33E-9, units of local government are required to make specific findings prior to authorizing any change order relative to a contract which would increase or decrease the dollar amount of the contract by \$10,000 or more, or would extend or shorten the time in which the contract is to be completed by thirty (30) days or more; and

WHEREAS, staff has presented and recommended the proposed Final Balancing Change Order to the contract between the Village of Lombard and Sheridan Plumbing & Sewer Co. regarding the Butterfield Rd Water Main Evaluation & Rehabilitation contract, as attached hereto as Exhibit "A" and made part hereof, (the "Change Order") to the Corporate Authorities of the Village of Lombard; and

WHEREAS, said Change Order attached hereto as Exhibit "A" would increase the contract amount by \$171,499.81 for a new contract total of \$912,299.81.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE PRESIDENT AND BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE VILLAGE OF LOMBARD, DU PAGE COUNTY, ILLINOIS, as follows:

SECTION 1: That after reviewing the explanation of staff as to the necessity of and reasons for the Change Order attached hereto as Exhibit "A", the President and Board of Trustees find as follows:

- A That the circumstances which necessitated said Change Order were not reasonably foreseeable at the time the contract was entered into.
- B. That the basis of the Change Order was not within the contemplation of the contract when the contract was signed.
- C. That it is in the best interests of the Village of Lombard to approve the Change Order in its proposed form.
- D. That to the extent that it may have been necessary to go to bid relative to the work contemplated by said Change Order; bidding is hereby specifically waived as to the Change Order work.

SECTION 2: That having made the findings set forth in Section 1 above, the President and Board of Trustees hereby approve the Change Order attached hereto as Exhibit "A", and direct and authorize the Village President and Village Clerk to execute said Change Order on behalf of the Village.
