

DuPage River Sweep 2005

- **WHEREAS,** the County of DuPage, through the Department of Environmental Concerns, recognizes ongoing stream cleaning as essential for the preservation of waterways throughout DuPage County and northeastern Illinois; and
- WHEREAS, stream cleaning efforts have been highly successful with more than 5,100 volunteers removing 155 tons of solid waste from DuPage County streams since 1991; and
- WHEREAS, the Conservation Foundation and Waste Management, Inc., in partnership with the DuPage County Department of Environmental Concerns, the Forest Preserve District of DuPage County and local municipalities, are sponsoring River Sweep 2005, a countywide stream cleaning effort, on Saturday June 4, 2005;
- **NOW, THEREFORE,** I, William J. Mueller, President of the Village of Lombard, do hereby proclaim the month of June 2005 as **Rivers Month** in the Village of Lombard; and
- **BE IT FURTHER PROCLAIMED** that all residents of Lombard are encouraged to learn about the environmental importance of clean waterways, and that all residents of Lombard are urged to support and participate in River Sweep 2005, a countywide stream cleaning effort on Saturday, June 4, 2005.
