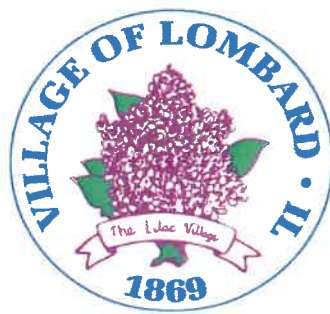

**ORDINANCE NO. 8388**

**AN ORDINANCE AMENDING TITLE XI, CHAPTER 112, SECTION 112.18(B)  
OF THE LOMBARD VILLAGE CODE IN REGARD TO ALCOHOLIC  
BEVERAGES, PROVIDING FOR THE SALE AND CONSUMPTION OF  
ALCOHOL IN CONNECTION WITH A TEMPORARY EVENT  
LOCATED ON VILLAGE-OWNED PROPERTY**

**BE IT ORDAINED** by the President and Board of Trustees of the Village of  
Lombard, DuPage County, Illinois, as follows:

**SECTION 1:** That Title XI, Chapter 112, Section 112.18(B) of the Lombard  
Village Code is hereby amended by adding a new subsection (5) thereto, effective upon  
the adoption of this Ordinance through 9:00 p.m. on Saturday, September 6, 2025, which  
shall read in its entirety, as follows:

“(5) That in association with a Food Truck Social event to be sponsored by  
the Lombard Historical Society, a not-for-profit organization, the Lombard  
Historical Society shall be eligible for a Class “J” liquor license for the sole  
purpose of selling beer, cider, mead, and seltzers for consumption on the  
licensed premises only, on Saturday, September 6, 2025, from 4:00 p.m. to  
9:00 p.m., in a designated and secured area, approved by the Village  
pursuant to the issuance of a temporary event permit under Chapter 110 of  
the Village Code. The liquor license to be issued under this subsection (5)  
may be issued by the Local Liquor Commissioner upon proper application  
to the Village, and satisfaction of all applicable requirements and conditions  
by the licensee. No liquor license shall be issued under this subsection (5)  
until such time as the licensee obtains the necessary temporary event permit  
under Chapter 110 of the Village Code, and complies with all requirements  
and conditions thereof, including, without limitation, the insurance, bond  
and indemnification requirements of Chapter 110 for temporary events.  
Video gaming, as provided for under the Illinois Video Gaming Act, shall  
not be allowed on the licensed premises.”

**SECTION 2:** That, effective at 9:00 p.m. on Saturday, September 6, 2025, Title XI,  
Chapter 112, Section 112.18(B)(5) of the Lombard Village Code, as set forth in Section 1  
above, is hereby repealed, without need for any further action by the President and Board  
of Trustees.

**SECTION 3:** This ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage and approval as provided by law.
