SUBJECT: Ammunition

Background

Every year the Lombard Police Department purchases practice and duty ammunition. Each officer is required to train with their authorized duty weapon and squad rifle during monthly qualification training. The Board of Trustees approved the expenditure of \$40,000 for the 2015 budget year for ammunition. This amount is consistent from past budget years.

In the past we have purchased ammunition throughout the year when the need presented itself. Unfortunately we have encountered issues regarding shortage of product and long delivery times due to high demand based on US Military engagements. Our goal is to purchase our entire supply of ammunition at the beginning of the year every year to ensure our supply is well stocked and at times create a small surplus for emergency situations.

The Lombard Police Department purchases ammunition from Ray O'Herron Co, Inc. Ray O'Herron holds the State of Illinois Ammunition Contract Pricing No. PSD4017592 for the majority of our ammunition needs. The balance that is not covered by the State Contract Pricing is highly competitive. The amount exceeds \$20,000 and would require Board of Trustees approval.

Recommendation

The Village staff recommends that the Village President and Board of Trustees authorize the purchase of ammunition from Ray O'Herron Co, Inc. in the amount not to exceed \$40,000.
