Subject: Large Diameter Sanitary Sewer Cleaning and Closed-Circuit Television Inspection (FY 26)

Description

The Sewer Cleaning and Televising Contract is a key component of the Village's Sewer Capacity, Management, Operations, and Maintenance (CMOM) Program. Televising is an essential tool for managing the sewer system, enabling staff to inspect and evaluate the internal condition of sewer infrastructure. When combined with the Village's Geographic Information System (GIS) and Asset Management Software (OpenGov), cleaning and televising activities allow staff to systematically catalog and assess the operational and structural condition of the sewer network. This data-driven approach supports strategic planning for future capital improvements, enables proactive scheduling of routine maintenance, and helps identify and prioritize necessary repairs.

The CMOM Program consolidates seven separate recurring maintenance programs, one of which is Large Diameter Sanitary Sewer Cleaning and Closed-Circuit Television (CCTV) Inspection. Consolidating multiple techniques and contracts provides Public Works with greater flexibility in the use of CIP funding and supports a more responsive and comprehensive maintenance and improvement strategy.

Funding

The FY 2026 Capital Improvement Plan (CIP) includes a total CMOM budget of \$882,000. Funds have already been allocated to two other contracts; Small Diameter Sewer Cleaning and Televising, and Sanitary Sewer Lining. Additional funds are allocated to Underground Utilities Division programs such as root treatment and a reserve for emergency digs and trench backfill (stone).

Bidding Process

Sewer cleaning and televising work is performed by specialty contractors. Proposals were solicited from four firms operating in the Chicagoland area that have demonstrated extensive experience with this type of work and have an established working relationship with the Village. The Request for Proposals was distributed via QuestCDN, the online bidding platform routinely used by the Public Works – Engineering Division

Results

Three (3) proposals were received on July 7, 2026, at 2:00 PM.

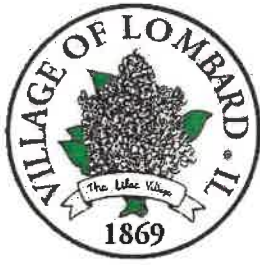
Contractor	Proposal Amount
Sewertech LLC	\$27,490.00
Hoerr Construction, Inc.	\$49,175.00
National Power Rodding Corp	\$397,250.00
Engineer's Estimate	\$125,900.00

Given that the lowest proposal was significantly below the Engineer's Estimate and well within the approved program budget, Public Works staff anticipates budgeting remaining CMOM funds to a future change order for additional cleaning and televising of large-diameter sewers. Priority will be given to sewer segments that experienced high flows and are in areas affected by localized flooding during the July 3–4 storm event.

Recommendation

The Engineering Division recommends awarding the Sanitary Sewer Lining Program (FY 26) to Sewertech LLC. in the amount of \$27,490.00.

Please present this item to the President and Board of Trustees for their review and approval at their regular meeting on July 16, 2026. If approved, please return two (2) executed copies of the Contract to Public Works Engineering for further processing.

Large Diameter Sanitary Sewer Cleaning and Closed-Circuit Television Inspection (FY 26)

This agreement is made on this 16th day of July 2026, between and shall be binding upon the Village of Lombard, an Illinois municipal corporation (hereinafter referred to as the "Village") and Sewertech LLC (hereinafter referred to as the "Contractor") and their respective successors.

Witnessed, that in consideration of the mutual promises of the parties delineated in the Contract Documents, the Contractor agrees to perform the services, and the Village agrees to pay for the following services as outlined in the Request for Proposal:

The quantities of work listed in Appendix A, Contract Quantities for \$27,490.00

1. This contract shall embrace and include all the applicable Contract Documents listed below as if attached hereto or repeated herein:

2. The Village agrees to pay, and the Contractor agrees to accept as full payment the amount as shown on the Contractor's Proposal, which is made a part hereof, subject to such additions and deletions as agreed to by the parties hereto.
3. The Contractor shall commence work under this Contract upon written Notice to Proceed from the Village and shall complete all work under this Contract by December 4, 2026. Time is of the essence regarding this Contract, and the Contractor agrees to achieve completion within the time permitted by all proper and appropriate means including working overtime without additional compensation.

4. Under the provisions of Section 5 of the Mechanics' Lien Act of Illinois, before making any payment to the Contractor under this Contract, the Village demands that the Contractor furnish a written statement of the names of all parties furnishing labor and/or materials under this Contract and the amounts due or to become due each. This statement must be made under oath or be verified by affidavit. The Village shall not issue final payment, nor shall any retained percentage become due until releases and waivers of lien have been supplied as the Village designates.
5. This Contract represents the entire agreement between the parties and may not be modified without the written approval of both parties.

IN WITNESS WHEREOF, the Village of Lombard, Illinois, and the Contractor have each hereunto caused this Contract to be executed by their respective duly authorized representatives this 16th day of July 2026.
