Subject:

Fleet Building Expansion Project, Equipment purchase

In accordance with the Village Board of Trustees adopted Strategic Plan, the Village staff has been working with TRIA Architects on plans for an expansion to the Fleet Services Facility. The facility was constructed in 1971 and is not adequate to service many of the Village's larger vehicles/pieces of equipment. The funding for the construction of the improvement is included in the 2023 CIP. It is anticipated that the project will be bid in January 2023.

Due to the current supply chain issues, staff is proposing purchasing some of the items for the project that have longer lead times. In addition to the time savings, the Village will be able to save money, as we have eliminated the mark-up that a contractor will place on these items. The construction contract will require the selected contractor to install the equipment provided by the Village. Over the next few months, staff will be presenting several requests to the Village Board to advance purchase items. The first request is for the heavy-duty vehicle lifts. The project includes three (3) heavy duty vehicle lifts capable of lifting any piece of equipment or fire apparatus the Village currently owns.

Bid specifications were sent to the Master Intergovernmental Cooperative Purchasing Agreement (MICPA) with Sourcewell (formally U.S. Communities Government Purchasing Alliance). Currently 497 communities in Illinois are participating in Sourcewell Purchasing Alliance. The Sourcewell Purchasing Alliance is a program that affords member communities an opportunity to participate in a program whereby a service or commodity is publically bid by a Lead Agency and the results of that competitive solicitation is available to all 90,000 public agencies. The Village used the same process for roofing projects on the Police Department, Village Hall and Public Works buildings. Stertil-Koni Equipment Corporation submitted the winning bid to Sourcewell for fleet supplies and vehicle lifts contract #013020-SKI. The bid results are as follows:

The addition of these heavy-duty lifts will provide staff with the flexibility to perform repairs and preventative maintenance on the entire fleet in a safe and efficient manner. The current lift is

limited in weight capacity and lacking modern safety features found on the newer lifts. There is a substantial lead time of 9-10 months for production of these lifts.

Staff is recommending approving the purchase of these lifts from Safetylane Equipment Corp. Bloomington, Indiana in the amount of \$442,972.80. Funding for the purchase will be through the Village's Building Reserve Fund.




