Subject: Retention of Surplus Vehicle

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The FY 2026 fleet replacement schedule included replacement of vehicle WT437 (vin# 1HTWGAZT9DH416745) a 2013 International Work Star 7400 with 30K miles. A replacement vehicle was ordered and WT437 was declared surplus. The new vehicle has been built and we took delivery on 4-19-2026.

After considering operational needs and a thorough inspection of the vehicle to be surplus, staff has determined the Village would be better served to retain this vehicle as a “stepdown” vehicle that would not have a depreciation spot funded. The vehicle has an anticipated salvage value of \$15,000.

If retained both the Street Group and Underground Utilities will have more operational flexibility throughout the year, especially during winter operations. The addition of this truck will allow better utilization of the 1,500-gallon anti-icing tank allowing for more opportunities to pre-treat roads ahead for snow events. It will assist the utilities group when repairing multiple water main breaks at the same time. During the fall leaf collection season this addition allows for a dedicated leaf hauling truck to continue leaf sweeping operations while having full preparedness of the salt trucks for potential snow events.

Staff requests permission to adopt an ordinance rescinding the surplus ordinance for WT437 a 2013 International Work Star dump truck (vin #1HTWGAZT9DH416745) and retain it as a stepdown vehicle in the public works fleet.

**AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. 8319  
AUTHORIZING THE SALE AND/OR DISPOSAL  
OF MUNICIPAL OWNED PERSONAL PROPERTY  
TO REMOVE UNIT # WT347 FROM THE SURPLUS PROPERTY LIST  
AND AUTHORIZE THE VILLAGE TO RETAIN SAID VEHICLE**

WHEREAS, the Village of Lombard (the “Village”) is the owner of certain municipal personal property, including the vehicle identified as Unit # WT437 (VIN # 1HTWGAZT9DH416745), a 2013 International tandem axle dump truck (the “Vehicle”); and

WHEREAS, by Ordinance No. 8319, adopted by the President and Board of Trustees of the Village of Lombard on January 23, 2025 (the “Prior Ordinance”), the Village declared certain municipal personal property, including the Vehicle, to be surplus property and authorized its sale and/or disposal pursuant to Section 11-76-4 of the Illinois Municipal Code, 65 ILCS 5/11-76-4; and

WHEREAS, subsequent to the adoption of the Prior Ordinance, Village staff determined that the Vehicle remains useful to the Village for Public Works purposes, including service in support of liquid anti-icing and pretreatment operations for winter maintenance; and

WHEREAS, the Corporate Authorities of the Village have determined that it is necessary, useful, and in the best interests of the Village to retain the Vehicle and remove the Vehicle from the list of personal property authorized to be sold and/or disposed of under the Prior Ordinance; and

WHEREAS, the Corporate Authorities desire to amend the Prior Ordinance only as to the Vehicle, and intend that the Prior Ordinance remain in full force and effect as to all other personal property described therein.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE PRESIDENT AND BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE VILLAGE OF LOMBARD, DU PAGE COUNTY, ILLINOIS, as follows:

**Section 1: Recitals.** The foregoing recitals are hereby incorporated into and made a part of this Ordinance as though fully set forth herein.

**Section 2: Amendment to Prior Ordinance; Removal of Vehicle from Surplus Property List.** The Prior Ordinance is hereby amended to delete and remove from the list of personal property declared surplus and authorized for sale and/or disposal the following vehicle: Unit # WT437 (VIN # 1HTWGAZT9DH416745), a 2013 International tandem axle dump truck

**Section 3: Retention of Vehicle.** The finding in the Prior Ordinance that the Vehicle is no longer necessary or useful to, or in the best interests of, the Village is hereby rescinded. The Vehicle shall be retained by the Village for municipal purposes unless and until the Corporate

Authorities take further action authorizing the sale, trade-in, disposal, or other disposition of the Vehicle.

**Section 4: Prior Ordinance Otherwise Unchanged.** Except as expressly amended by this Ordinance, the Prior Ordinance shall remain in full force and effect, including, without limitation, the authorization to sell and/or dispose of the other municipal personal property described therein.

**Section 5: Effective Date.** This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its adoption and approval as provided by law.
