Background

Approximately 26% of the sanitary sewer overflows that have occurred during the past six years have been due tree roots clogging the sewer mains. The Underground Utilities Division of the Department of Public Works cleans approximately 20% of the sanitary sewer mains less than 15 inches in diameter each year. Many of the mains require root cutting to clean the line because the mains were installed in the parkways or backyards. Underground Utilities has limited capabilities to chemically treat the sewer mains with it's existing equipment, and determined the process to be inefficient and time consuming. Treatment has been successful in chemically treating the sewer services and found the chemical to reduce the re-growth of roots.

Duke's Root Control, Inc. of Syracuse, NY chemically treated approximately 24,000 ft of sewer main during the Fall, 2007 and 24,000 ft in the Fall, 2008. Their treatment is guaranteed for two years from the date of initial application and three years for the second application. This year will be the second application for the sewers treated in 2008, extending the guarantee to three years. During this time none of the sewers that have been treated backed up again. The company was professional and performed satisfactorily. The chemical used by Duke's has less of an environmental impact and is safer to use than that of other root chemical control companies.

The Village has \$50,000 budgeted Sewer Root Control in the Water & Sewer Capital Reserve Fund to continue this program. Attached is a proposal from Duke's Root Control for the current year's pricing. Payment for work performed will be based upon measured quantities multiplied by the contract unit prices.

Recommendation

Please request the Board of Trustees to waive bids and award a contract in an amount not to exceed the budgeted amount of \$50,000 for sewer root control to Duke's Root Control, Inc. of Syracuse, NY at their October 7, 2010 meeting.
