Subject: Purchase of replacement streetlight poles for Parkside Ave

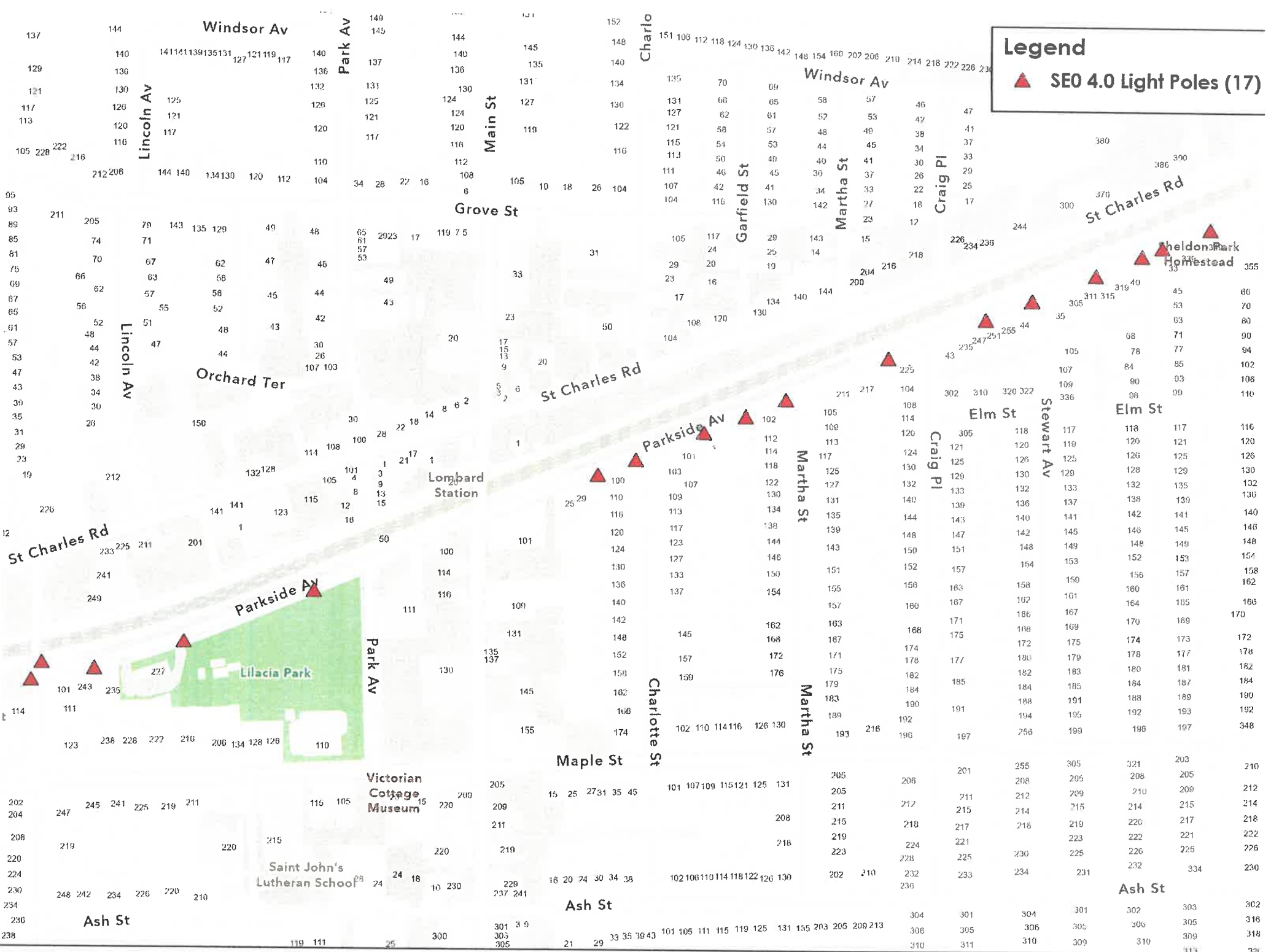
The Village of Lombard was approved for a \$50,000 Rebuild Illinois Capital Grant (25-203755). The grant is administered by the Illinois Department of Commerce and Economic Opportunity (CDOC). Staff identified replacement of 22 deteriorating concrete streetlight poles along Parkside Ave. from Grace St. to Elizabeth St. as an approved expenditure of these funds.

Price quotes were requested from the two approved light pole vendors, Ameron and StressCrete. Ameron Pole Products of Dallas (TX) provided the lowest price of \$51,348 for 22 streetlight poles. The grant is a reimbursable grant. The purchase will be made from funds in account 416.710.118.75770 and submitted to the DCEO for reimbursement.

Staff recommends the Board of Trustees waive the competitive bid process and award a contract to Ameron Pole Products of Dallas (TX) in the amount of \$51,348 for the purchase of 22 concrete streetlight poles. Please submit this item to the Village Board for their consideration at the August 20, 2026 meeting.

- * All control products will require submittal sets generated by KSA. Full Submittal sets are available upon receipt of HFR Purchase orders and require approximately 2 weeks to produce. Device color, voltage and counts must be verified prior to project release.
- * Electric Mirror: The Ocean Freight market has recently seen significant increases in pricing and remains volatile. It is uncertain how long the current situation will last, and the extent of additional shipping cost increases. This instability has a direct impact on the cost of our imported products. The situation requires that we prepare you for increased freight costs associated with your order(s). All quotes are based on standard ocean logistics/freight rates that existed prior to current world-wide logistics issues and the significant spike in costs. Given these unforeseen increases, a surcharge will be required at the time of shipping your product. These additional costs will be estimated upon receipt of your purchase order and actualized at the time of shipment. The logistics surcharge, calculated as a percentage of the net price of imported products on your order, will be updated prior to shipping in determining the final billing to you. The rates are subject to change based on market conditions. The surcharge will be added to individual orders greater than \$10,000 net value of imported product.
