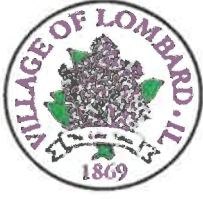

**SUBJECT: Request for a Class “F” Liquor License
Jay Hari, Inc. d/b/a Royal Liquor – 594 S. Main Street – New Location**

The owner of Jay Hari, Inc. d/b/a Royal Liquor, located at 338 S. Main Street, currently holds a Class “F” liquor license. The primary purpose of this establishment is the sale of alcoholic liquors, not for consumption on the premises (Package Store).

The Village received a request for a Class “F” liquor license from the current owner of Jay Hari, Inc. d/b/a Royal Liquor, to relocate the current business to a new location at 594 S. Main Street, earlier in the year for the July 1, - December 31, 2025, license term. Following conversations with the Liquor Commissioner at that time, the applicant initiated steps to prepare for the relocation of the current business to the proposed location at 594 S. Main Street.

Royal Liquor originally opened in 2015 and had change of ownership in 2021 with the original and current owner remaining as part of that ownership.

Attached is an ordinance amending Title XI, Chapter 112, Section 112.13(A) decreasing and increasing the Class “F” liquor license category by one (1) relative to the Entity Liquor Licensee Jay Hari, Inc. no longer conducting business at 338 S. Main Street and issuance of a Class “F” Liquor License to conduct business at the new location, 594 S. Main Street. Upon approval of the license for the location at 594 S. Main Street, the operations at 338 S. Main Street will terminate and the license will be active for only the relocated space at 594 S. Main Street.

Staff is requesting a waiver of first reading at the September 18, 2025, Board of Trustees meeting.

ORDINANCE _____

**AN ORDINANCE AMENDING TITLE 11, CHAPTER 112,
SECTION 112.13 (A) OF THE LOMBARD VILLAGE CODE IN
REGARD TO ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGES**

**BE IT ORDAINED BY THE PRESIDENT AND BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE
VILLAGE OF LOMBARD, DU PAGE COUNTY, ILLINOIS** as follows:

Section 1: That Title 11, Chapter 112, Section 112.13 (A) of the Lombard Village Code is amended by revising the entry relative to the Class “F” liquor license category, contained therein, to read as follows:

Class “F” – 4

This decrease in the number of Class “F” liquor licenses reflects the ceasing of business by Jay Hari, Inc. d/b/a Royal Liquor, at 338 S. Main Street and the termination of the Class “F” liquor license issued to Jay Hari, Inc. d/b/a Royal Liquor. in relation thereto.

Section 2: That Title 11, Chapter 112, Section 112.13 (A) of the Lombard Village Code is amended by revising the entry relative to the Class “F” liquor license category, contained therein, to read as follows:

Class “F” – 5

This increase in the number of Class “F” liquor licenses reflects the issuance of a Class “F” liquor license to Jay Hari, Inc. d/b/a Royal Liquor who will be operating the business, at its new location, 594 S. Main Street, Lombard, IL.

Section 3: This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage and approval as required by law.
