**Subject:** Suburban Tree Consortium Bid waiver

On August 4, 1988, the Village Board approved participation in the Suburban Tree Consortium. Representing 50 member communities, this organization handles the tree planting bid process in accordance with State of Illinois law. As a member, the Village must commit to a lead-time of five years for the purchase of trees grown based upon projected orders for trees.

\$143,450.00 is currently budgeted for parkway tree planting for FY25. This figure will result in approximately 365 trees being planted in the Spring & Fall 2025 planting seasons, including replacement trees removed between Spring 2023 and Summer 2024, 35 Community Development trees and eight (8) trees along the E. St. Charles Road corridor as part of the sidewalk replacement project. As a formality, the Village Attorney has recommended waiving bids and approval of this payment.

The Suburban Tree Consortium provides quality trees grown specifically for parkway conditions. West Central Municipal Conference acts as the Secretariat for the Suburban Tree Consortium. We have received quality trees and installation in the past and recommend waiver of bids in an amount not to exceed \$143,450.00 for trees through the West Central Municipal Conference for FY25.
