Parking Survey Results for View St. between West Rd. and Elizabeth St.

History


On February 21, 2000 "No Parking" signs were installed on the south side of View St. between West Rd. and Elizabeth St. These signs were installed to alleviate congestion caused by school functions and park activities. There have been questions as to why a full-time restriction versus a school day restriction was applied. On June 7, 2001 a survey was mailed to 17 residents directly affected by the "No Parking" zone. The following are the facts collected from the survey:

- 17 surveys were mailed to residents and 11 surveys were returned by the July 1, 2001 deadline.
- 1 survey was not completed.
- 2 surveys indicated Remove all parking restrictions on the south side of View St. between West Rd. and Elizabeth St.
- 3 surveys indicated Leave "No Parking" signage as is on the south side of View St. between West Rd. and Elizabeth St.
- 5 surveys indicated Change signage to read, "No Parking, School Days, 8 am-4pm".

The surveys contained many comments and concerns regarding View St. parking. The returned survey forms will be copied and distributed to the Transportation and Safety Committee members for their review and discussion at the next meeting. The Transportation and Safety Committee normally meets the first Monday of the month in the Village Hall at 7:30 PM. An August 6, 2001 Transportation and Safety Committee meeting has been scheduled.
