#### CONTRACT DOCUMENT FY 2022 Water Distribution System Leak Detection Survey

This agreement is made 21<sup>st</sup> day of July, 2022 by and between, and shall be binding upon, the Village of Lombard, an Illinois municipal Corporation hereinafter referred to as (the "Village") and <u>Water Services</u> <u>Co. of Elgin, IL</u> hereinafter referred to as (the "Contractor").

  - b. The Contractor's Bid Proposal Dated July 8, 2022.
  - c. Required Performance and Payment Bonds and Certificate of Insurance
- 2. The Village agrees to pay, and the Contractor agrees to accept as full payment for the services which are the subject matter of this Contract the total sum not to exceed \$27,600.00 paid in accordance with the provisions of the Local Government Prompt Payment Act and the provisions of the Contract Documents.

- 3. Contractor shall not delegate the duties involved in the performance of the services which are the subject matter of this Contract without the written approval of the Village.
- 4. This Contract represents the entire agreement between the parties and may not be modified without the written approval of both parties.
- 5. Where the terms of this Contract conflict with the provisions of the Contract Documents, the Contract Documents shall be binding.
