On February 21, 2000 "No Parking" signs were installed on the south side of View St. between West Rd. and Elizabeth St. These sign were installed to alleviate congestion caused by school functions and park activities. There have been questions as to why a full-time restriction versus a school day restriction. The following is a survey to get the feel of the neighborhood as to what the majority would like to see on their street. The only suggestion I have is that any parking restrictions should be posted on the south side of View St. This will allow vehicles to move away from the school and not add congestion at View St. and Elizabeth St. intersection.
