FY 2025-2026 Season Road Salt Purchase

The 2024-2025 winter season required the Village to use approximately 1700 tons of the road salt supply that it had in reserve.

The Village has previously participated in DuPage County Department of Transportation's salt bid. Bids for this contract were opened June 24, 2025. Compass Minerals America, Inc. was the lowest bidder with a per ton cost of \$70.79 and will be the provider of bulk road salt for the County's contract. The new contract is \$3.11 less than the previous year.

Staff would like to exercise the option of purchasing up to 130% of the requested 4,500 tons of salt to replenish the salt that was used during the 2024-2025 and 2025-2026 seasons. Village staff exercised the option to only purchase 80% of the contract allotted salt from the 2024-2025 salt contract.

The Village has approximately 3200 tons of salt in reserve in the salt storage dome. The Village can begin to accept deliveries of salt under the 2025-2026 contract from November 2025 to May 31, 2026.

Salt purchase of \$318,555.00 will be paid for by the MFT fund 420.730.730.73310 in FY 2025.
