FY10 New Vehicle Purchase

The FY10 budget includes the replacement of Village unit # FR4, a 2000 Ford Excursion used by the Fire Department. The replacement for this vehicle, a Ford Expedition, is available for purchase through the Northwest Municipal Conference (NWMC) joint purchasing program. Sutton Ford of Matteson (IL) is the current NWMC contract winner. The vehicle price is \$26,936 and the budgeted amount for this purchase is \$35,000.

I recommend the B.O.T waive bid and award a contract to Sutton Ford of Matteson (IL) in the amount of \$26,936 for a new Ford Expedition. I also recommend declaring Village unit # FR4, a 2000 Ford Excursion, as surplus per the attached ordinance and authorizing its sale at the Tri-State Auto Auction of Chicago. Waiver of first reading is requested on this ordinance. Please submit this item to the Village Board for their consideration at the August 20, 2009 meeting.

## AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE SALE BY PUBLIC AUCTION OF PERSONAL PROPERTY OWNED BY THE VILLAGE OF LOMBARD

WHEREAS, in the opinion of the Corporate Authorities of the Village of Lombard, it is no longer necessary or useful to or in the best interest for the Village of Lombard to retain ownership of the personal property hereinafter described; and

WHEREAS, it has been determined by the President and Board of Trustees of the Village of Lombard to sell said personal property at public auction to be held weekly on Mondays, Wednesdays, and Thursdays in conjunction with the Tri-State Automobile Auction of Chicago. Vehicles valued less than the cost of auction fees and would not result in a net profit for the Village shall be sold directly to a salvage yard.

## NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE PRESIDENT AND BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE VILLAGE OF LOMBARD, DU PAGE COUNTY, ILLINOIS, as follows:
