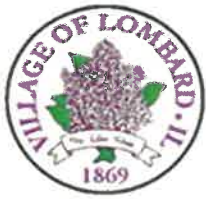

The Village has received a request for a Class “A/B-I” liquor license from the owner of Uzu Yorktown, LLC d/b/a Uzumaki Revolving Sushi, located at 326 Yorktown Shopping Center, for the remainder of the current license term January 1 - June 30, 2026.

Uzumaki Revolving Sushi is a full-service Japanese restaurant that features a revolving sushi conveyor system to serve their guests, offering a high-quality sushi with a modernized touch. There is a full menu that includes alcohol service with the purpose of being complementary to the food service; food will always be available when selling and serving alcoholic beverages. The owners plan to sell beer, wine, sake, and soju, for onsite consumption only.

The owner has over 25 years of experience in the restaurant and food industry and has owned and operated the following within the Chicago Metropolitan area, Poke Burrito; Mochii Donut; and within Downtown Chicago, Umi Sush, and 153 Akira, located in Wilmette, IL.

Attached is an ordinance increasing the Class “A/B-I” liquor license category by one and issuing a liquor license to Uzu Yorktown, LLC d/b/a Uzumaki Revolving Sushi, located at 326 Yorktown Shopping Center.

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING TITLE XI, CHAPTER 112, SECTION 112.13(A) OF THE LOMBARD VILLAGE CODE IN REGARD TO THE NUMBER OF CLASS "A/B-I" LIQUOR LICENSES

BE IT ORDAINED by the President and Board of Trustees of the Village of Lombard, DuPage County, Illinois, as follows:

SECTION 1: That Title XI, Chapter 112, Section 112.13(A) of the Lombard Village Code is amended by revising the language therein, relative to the Class "A/B-I" liquor license category, to read in its entirety as follows:

"A/B-I" – 5"

This increase in the number of Class "A/B-I" liquor licenses reflects the issuance of a new Class "A/B-I" liquor license to Uzu Yorktown, LLC d/b/a Uzumaki Revolving Sushi, located at 326 Yorktown Shopping Center, Lombard, Illinois.

SECTION 2: That this Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage, approval and publication in pamphlet form, as provided by law.
