## AN ORDINANCE AMENDING TITLE 11, CHAPTER 112, SECTION 112.13 OF THE LOMBARD VILLAGE CODE IN REGARD TO ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGES

## BE IT ORDAINED BY THE PRESIDENT AND BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE VILLAGE OF LOMBARD, DU PAGE COUNTY, ILLINOIS as follows:

Section 1: That Title 11, Chapter 112, Section 112.13 (A) of the Lombard Village Code is amended by revising the entry relative to the Class C liquor license, contained therein, to read as follows:
