Further Time Extension of Ordinances 6347, 6481, 6625 & 6721

The Board of Trustees approved Ordinance 6347 (PC 09-08) on June 18, 2009 which granted conditional use approval for a planned development with companion deviations and variations, and a conditional use for a school, private, full-time: Elementary, Middle and High, for the property at 331 W. Madison St. Three time extensions were granted after the adoption of Ordinance 6347 -- May 20, 2010 (Ordinance 6481), June 2, 2011 (Ordinance 6625) and May 17, 2012 (Ordinance 6721). Ordinance 6721 was approved by the Board of Trustees for a six-month period. As such, construction was required to commence on the project prior to December 18, 2012. To date, the Village has yet to receive any final engineering or building permit submittals needed in order to commence construction.

Staff sent several correspondences advising of the impending timeline. Staff first informed the petitioner that staff would not be supportive of any further time extensions prior to the approval of Ordinance 6721 (third extension) as it would be four years removed from the original approval of the project. Furthermore, follow-up letters were sent to the petitioner on July 19, 2012 and November 26, 2012 advising of the Ordinance expiration. In the motion of the time extension approval earlier this year, the trustee of the district also stated his desire not to grant further extensions.

The petitioner has submitted the attached request seeking additional consideration in the form of a fourth extension of the conditional use approval, citing severe financial difficulties in project fund raising as the rationale. While staff recognizes the impact of recent economic difficulties on fundraising efforts, staff believes that it is in the best interest of the surrounding neighborhood and Village to not extend the relief. If such relief were to expire, CPSA would still have the opportunity to apply for zoning approvals in the future.

Time extensions to previously granted relief would be a discretionary item of the Village Board. Should the Village Board desire to approve a further Ordinance extension, staff has attached a draft ordinance for an additional one-year period, thus expiring December 31, 2013.

RECOMMENDATION:

Please place this on the December 20, 2012 Village Board agenda. Staff recommends that the Village Board deny an Ordinance further extending the time period for the previously approved conditional use.

AN ORDINANCE GRANTING A FURTHER TIME EXTENSION TO ORDINANCES 6347, 6481, 6625 & 6721

(PC 09-08: 331 W. Madison – CPSA School)

WHEREAS, on June 18, 2009, the President and Board of Trustees of the Village of Lombard adopted Ordinance 6347, granting a conditional use for a planned development with companion deviations and variations, and a conditional use for a school, private, full-time: Elementary, Middle and High, for the property at 331 W. Madison St; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to Section 155.103 (F)(12) of the Lombard Zoning Ordinance, otherwise known as Title 15, Chapter 155 of the Code of Lombard, Illinois, conditional uses are null and void if the conditional use ceases for more than one year from the date of granting thereof, unless further action is taken by the Village Board; and,

WHEREAS, on May 20, 2010, the President and Board of Trustees of the Village of Lombard adopted Ordinance 6481 granting an extension to the conditional use approval for a one year period (June 18, 2011); and

WHEREAS, on June 2, 2011, the President and Board of Trustees of the Village of Lombard adopted Ordinance 6625 granting a further time extension to the conditional use approval for a one year period (June 18, 2012); and

WHEREAS, on May 17, 2012 the President and Board of Trustees of the Village of Lombard adopted Ordinance 6721 granting a further time extension to the conditional use approval for a six month period (December 18, 2012); and

WHEREAS, construction has not commenced and no building permit has been issued for the development granted by Ordinances 6347, 6481, 6625 and 6721; and

WHEREAS, the Village has received a letter requesting a further extension of Ordinances 6347, 6481, 6625 and 6721; and

WHEREAS, the President and Board of Trustees have determined that it is in the best interests of the Village of Lombard to grant said extension.
