No Parking on Garfield Street

No Parking, East Side of N. Garfield Street

A 30-day temporary regulation has been enacted in accordance with the Village of Lombard Traffic Code, section 10-3-8. This regulation was enacted to address an unsatisfactory parking situation occurring at 1051 N. Garfield Street. Though "No Parking" signs are posted on the east side of Garfield Street, no such designation could be found in the Traffic Code. Therefore, in order to enforce the posted regulations, staff recommends modifying the Traffic Code as described below.

The following sections of the traffic code require an ordinance:

Schedule VII - Parking Prohibited at all Times on Certain Streets

Add: East side of Garfield Street from the north curb line of Progress Drive to a point 1355 feet north.

Attached are a copy of the "Authorization for Temporary or Emergency Placement of Traffic Control Regulation or Device" and a map of the existing and proposed No Parking Zones on N. Garfield Street for your reference.

AUTHORIZATION FOR TEMPORARY OR EMERGENCY PLACEMENT OF TRAFFIC CONTROL REGULATION OR DEVICE

Pursuant to the Village of Lombard Traffic Code, section 10-3-8, the below listed temporary or experimental regulation is authorized as an emergency or special condition: (please specify)

At 1051 N. Garfield Street a new business opened. This business deals with wholesaling vehicles. At times there are numerous trucks parked on the roadway for the purpose of loading and unloading vehicles, although they have two parking lots that would serve this purpose They can and are delaying other truck traffic for the other area businesses by blocking the roadway. There have been many complaints from the other businesses regarding the parking situation. The east side of Garfield is mostly signed "No Parking" with the exception of 1051 N. Garfield Street. For some reason there is not an ordinance covering the east side of the street. I would recommend the east side of Garfield Street from Progress Road to a point 1355 feet north be posted "No Parking".
