- K. [250005](#) **Village Right-of-Way Tree and Stump Removal Contract Renewal**
Request for a waiver of bids and award of a contract to Homer Tree Care, Inc. in the amount not to exceed \$52,495.00. This is the first of two possible one-year extensions of the contract and will expire December 31, 2025. (DISTRICTS - ALL)
- L. [250007](#) **Thomas Engineering Services Professional Services Agreement**
Staff requests that the Village Board approve a professional services agreement with Thomas Engineering Group to continue to perform engineering inspection activities on behalf of the Village Community Development Department for the 2025 calendar year.

M. [250008](#) **Detention Pond Maintenance and Improvements Program - Water Surface Monitoring Services**
Request for a waiver of bids and award of a contract with Environmental Aquatic Management, LLC of Algonquin in an amount not to exceed \$23,100.00 for 2025 and \$24,000.00 for 2026 for the monitoring and maintenance of the water surfaces at the Village Complex Pond, Terrace View Pond and Morris Pond.
