Interoffice Memo

Description;

The purpose of this yearly maintenance program is to extend the service life of manholes within the sanitary and storm sewer network. Recent efforts have focused on the sanitary sewer collection system. The scope of work includes spray lining, applying internal chimney seals, root control, grouting and wiping joints, and repairing benches and inverts.

Bidding Process

The contract was bid through a joint purchase process developed by communities located within DuPage County. The Municipal Purchasing Initiative (MPI) is a process by which one community serves as the lead agency, in this case, the Village of Bartlett and other communities may choose to add pay items and respective quantities to the bid schedule. Each participating community can then choose to award a contract based upon their quantities of the pay items included within the bid package. This year's participating agencies include the Village of Bartlett and the Village of Roselle. Public Works staff exercised an option within the contract for other communities to "piggyback" on the lowest responsible bidders unit prices. The submitted prices were assessed as very favorable.

Results

Bids were advertised in the Bartlett Examiner and on the Village of Bartlett's website. Three bid packages were picked up and three bids were received and opened on April 6, 2022. The lowest responsible bidder was Structured Solutions, L.L.C. of Union City, Indiana.

Recommendation:

The Engineering Division recommends awarding this contract to the Structured Solutions, L.L.C. in the amount of \$145,122.00
