SUBJECT: Parking Restrictions – Wilson Avenue

Request

Staff recommend amending Section 10-13-6 and Schedule XX of the Traffic Code to establish a No Stopping, Standing or Parking zone on the south side of Wilson Avenue from the east curb line of Lincoln Avenue to the west curb line of Main Street.

Background

There are existing parking restrictions on Wilson Avenue, near Glenbard East High School (GEHS). The north side of the street is a No Parking zone from Finley Road, extending east to the eastern edge of Madison Meadow Park. The south side of the street is a No Parking zone, except for the portion 265' east of Edson Avenue to Lincoln Avenue. (See Exhibit A)

Prior to February of 2025, parents and guardians were allowed to drive upon GEHS property to pick up their students. The parents and guardians would queue on GEHS property until the student entered the vehicle.

In February of 2025, Glenbard East High School (GEHS) made a significant change to their pick-up policy, prohibiting parents or guardians from driving on GEHS property to pick up students. This resulted in a significant increase in vehicles stopped along the no parking zones on the south side of Wilson Ave.

As the roadway was not designed to have vehicles occupying this area, eastbound through traffic must violate the painted median on the roadway, to get around the stopped/standing vehicles to make their way to Main Street (See Exhibit B). Also, during dismissal, students were observed walking between the stopped vehicles and into traffic (either to cross the street or to access a drivers' side door) causing a substantial personal injury risk. The traffic issues that developed due to the GEHS policy change also created an issue for emergency vehicles entering the area and delaying response time for any emergency response or call for service.

Following the policy change, the police department utilized several officers and community service officers over the next month to attempt to facilitate a safe travel pathway and were met with resistance from vehicle occupants who were there to pick up their student(s). The overwhelming complaint from the vehicle occupants was to challenge our officers on the current roadway signage that only prohibits parking, which by definition is leaving their vehicle unoccupied.

Analysis

To improve safety and achieve the original goal of the restrictions on the south side of Wilson Avenue, this would require amending the current No Parking zone to a No Standing, Stopping or Parking zone.

One concern that staff has is that every existing No Parking area is subject to the same enforcement limitations that were brought to light by the GEHS parents and guardians. It is possible that those waiting for student pick-up use a different No Parking zone, such as the north side of Wilson Avenue. While we hope that will not be the case, there may be a future need to enact similar restrictions on the north side of Wilson Avenue or other locations.

In order to amend the Village Traffic Code, there are 3 modifications required. Removal of the existing No Parking zone in Schedule VII, addition of modified No Parking zone in Schedule VII, and an addition of the new No Stopping, Standing or Parking zone to Schedule XX:

This recommendation was initially presented to the Public Safety and Transportation Committee at the June 4, 2025 meeting. The Committee supports the proposed amendment to the Lombard Traffic Code and requested that this matter be placed on the Village Board agenda for the June 19, 2025 for consideration.

Recommendation

Staff recommend amending Section 10-13-6 and Schedule XX of the Village Traffic Code to remove the existing No Parking zone on the south side of Wilson Avenue from Lincoln Avenue to 266 feet east of Main Street, and adding both a No Stopping, Standing or Parking zone on Wilson Avenue from the east curb line of Lincoln Avenue to the west curb line of Main Street and a No Parking zone from the east curb line of Main Street to a point 265 feet east.

ORDINANCE AMENDING ARTICLE XIII OF THE LOMBARD TRAFFIC CODE TO ADD PARKING PROHIBITIONS ON WILSON AVENUE

WHEREAS, the President and Board of Trustees of the Village of Lombard have heretofore passed and approved Ordinance 1186, An Ordinance Regulating Traffic in the Village of Lombard (hereinafter the Lombard Traffic Code); and

WHEREAS, the President and Board of Trustees of the Village of Lombard find that the Lombard Traffic Code has been amended from time to time; and

WHEREAS, the Public Safety and Transportation Committee has reviewed the appropriate traffic studies and recommends certain changes to the Lombard Traffic Code; and

WHEREAS, the Corporate Authorities of the Village of Lombard concur with the recommendation of the Transportation and Safety Committee.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE PRESIDENT AND BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE VILLAGE OF LOMBARD, DU PAGE COUNTY, ILLINOIS, as follows:

Section 1: That Article XIII, Schedule VII, of the Lombard Traffic Code (Ordinance 1186) be amended by removing the language as follows:
