DOC Wine Bar - 326 Yorktown

DOC West LLC d/b/a DOC Wine Bar located at 326 Yorktown currently holds a Class "N-I" liquor license which allows them to serve alcoholic beverages served in relation to food service with package wine and champagne sales allowed. AN ORDINANCE AMENDING TITLE XI, CHAPTER 112, SECTION 112.13(A) OF THE LOMBARD VILLAGE CODE IN REGARD TO ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGES

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE PRESIDENT AND BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE VILLAGE OF LOMBARD, DU PAGE COUNTY, ILLINOIS as follows:

Section 1: That Title XI, Chapter 112, Section 112.13(A) of the Lombard Village Code is amended by revising the entry relative to the Class "N-I" liquor license category contained therein, to read as follows:

Class "N-I"- 0

Section 2: That the decrease in the number of Class "N-I" liquor licenses set forth in Section 1 above, is a result of DOC West LLC d/b/a DOC Wine Bar located at 326 Yorktown voluntarily cancelling their liquor license as they are no longer conducting business.

Section 3: This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage and approval as required by law.
