FY 2023 Sidewalk and Curb Improvement Program

The purpose of the Sidewalk and Curb Improvement Program is to address deteriorated and damaged sections of sidewalk, curb and parkway damaged by utility digs. The program is comprised of the following categories: Parkway Restoration, Deteriorated Sidewalk (50/50 Program), Trip Hazard Repairs, Curb Replacement Program and ADA.

This contract was originally bid through the MPI process developed by communities in the DuPage Region for the 2022 fiscal year. The MPI process aggregates quantities from multiple agencies for the purpose of bidding and to seek lower unit prices for all agencies involved in the bid process. Through the MPI process, one agency serves as the lead agency. Once the bidding process has been completed, each participating agency awards a contract to their lowest responsible bidder. The 2022 bid allowed two one-year extensions at 5% each, if mutually agreed upon. Lombard's award for 2022 year went to Schroeder & Schroeder Ltd., who has declined to extend the contract.

Globe Construction Inc. was Lombard's next lowest bidder in 2022, at only \$2,619.50 more. They had been Lombard's contractor for the three years prior to 2022. Globe has agreed to honor their unit bid prices from 2022, plus a 6% unit price increase for the 2023 program. Based on discussions with other contractors, putting this contract out to bid would risk a 20-30% increase in prices due to material shortage concerns and inflation in the cost of materials.

The 2023 Capital Improvement Plan contains funds for the 2023 Sidewalk and Curb Improvement Program contract as follows. A portion of the Concrete Roadway Program would be used to make up the \$46,185.55 budget shortfall in the Sidewalk & Curb Improvement Program.

The Public Works Department recommends that the Village President and Board of Trustees waive bid and award the contract to Globe Construction Inc. in the amount of \$304,185.55 for the 2023 Sidewalk and Curb Improvement Program contract.

- 2. The Village agrees to pay, and the Contractor agrees to accept as full payment the amount as shown on the Contractor's Bid Proposal, which is made a part hereof, subject to such additions and deletions as agreed to by the parties hereto.
- 3. The Contractor shall commence work under this Contract upon written Notice to Proceed from the Village and shall complete work under this contract on or before October 31, 2023. Time is of the essence in regard to this Contract, and the Contractor agrees to achieve

completion within the time permitted by all proper and appropriate means including working overtime without additional compensation.

- 4. Pursuant to the provisions of Section 5 of the Mechanics' Lien Act of Illinois, prior to making any payment to the Contractor under this Contract, the Village demands that the Contractor furnish a written statement of the names of all parties furnishing labor and/or materials under this Contract and the amounts due or to become due each. This statement must be made under oath or be verified by affidavit. The Village shall not issue final payment nor shall any retained percentage become due until releases and waivers of lien have been supplied as the Village designates.
- 5. This Contract represents the entire agreement between the parties and may not be modified without the written approval of both parties.
