Subject:	Tree Consortium Bid waiver

On August 4, 1988, the Village Board approved participation in the Suburban Tree Consortium. Representing 45 member communities, this organization handles the tree planting bid process in accordance with State of Illinois law. As a member, the Village must commit to a lead-time of five years for the purchase of trees grown based upon projected orders for trees.

\$79,200.00 is currently budgeted for parkway tree planting for FY20. This figure represents approximately 260 trees scheduled be planted in the Spring & Fall of 2020 planting seasons. As a formality, the Village Attorney has recommended waiving bids and approval of this payment.

In light of the fiscal uncertainties arising from the Covid-19 pandemic, the Village is electing to forego the planting of parkway trees in Fall of 2020. The elimination of the 55 trees originally scheduled for Fall will result in a savings of \$18,200.00.

The Suburban Tree Consortium provides top quality trees grown specifically for parkway conditions. We have received a superior product in the past and recommend waiver of bids in an amount not to exceed \$61,000.00 for trees from the Suburban Tree Consortium for FY20.
