Supply Course Aggregate Material, including delivery, at a unit cost of \$13.73/ton for CA-6 and \$18.33/ton for CA-7 in an amount not to exceed \$36,000.

- 2. The Village agrees to pay, and the Contractor agrees to accept as full payment for the items which are the subject matter of this Contract in an amount not to exceed \$36,000.00 paid in accordance with the provisions of the Local Government Prompt Payment Act and the provisions of the Contract Documents.
- 3. Risk of loss, destruction or damage of or to goods under this Contract shall be on contractor until delivery of the goods to the Village and acceptance of the goods by the Village.
- 4. Contractor agrees to perform the terms of this Contract by December 31, 2020.

Where the terms of this Contract conflict with the provisions of the Contract Documents, the Contract Documents shall be binding.
