# E. 190452 Ordinance Declaring Five Village Vehicles as Surplus and Authorizing Their Sale; and Authorizing the Purchase of Five Ford Interceptor Utility Vehicles

Request for a waiver of bids and award of a contract to Currie Motors in the amount of \$201,842.00. This item was competitively bid through the Suburban Purchasing Cooperative (SPC contract #152), a joint purchasing program in which the Village participates. Staff requests approval of an Ordinance declaring Village units PP749, PP750, PP751, PP795 (all 2015 Ford Interceptor Utility Vehicles) and FA1 (a 2010 Ford Explorer) as surplus and authorizing their sale at public auction, as well as waiver of first reading.
