Subject: PC 18-01, Text Amendment to the Zoning Ordinance

Dear President and Trustees:

Your Plan Commission transmits for your consideration its recommendation regarding the above-referenced petition. The petitioner, the Village of Lombard, requests text amendments to Section 155.602 Table 6.3 of the Lombard Zoning Ordinance (and any other relevant sections for clarity) to amend the parking for hotels, motels and similar uses.

After due notice and as required by law, the Plan Commission conducted a public hearing for this petition on January 22, 2018. Sworn in to present the petition was Anna Papke, Senior Planner.

Chairperson Ryan read the Plan Commission procedures and asked if anyone other than the petitioner intended to cross examine and, hearing none, he proceeded with the petition.

Chairperson Ryan asked if any person would like to speak in favor or against this petition, or for public comment. Hearing none, he asked for the staff report.

Ms. Papke presented the staff report, which was submitted to the public record in its entirety. The Village is requesting a text amendment to the zoning ordinance to change the parking requirements for hotels and motels. Currently, the Zoning Ordinance requires one parking space per guest room plus one space per employee on peak shift. The Village proposes to amend the code so that the parking requirement is based on the size and function of the space rather than employee numbers, which are subject to change and are difficult for the Village to verify. Staff researched hotel occupancy

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rates in DuPage County and conducted parking counts at Lombard hotels. Staff recommends amending the parking requirement for hotels, motels and similar uses to one parking space per guest room. Staff notes that this text amendment will not affect the parking standard for hotel/convention hall, which is listed separately in the parking standards table.

Chairperson Ryan asked for public comment, and, hearing none, opened the meeting for comments among the Commissioners.

Commissioner Flint asked if one space per room seemed to be standard among the other communities surveyed. Ms. Papke said it was.

On a motion by Commissioner Sweetser, and a second by Commissioner Flint, the Plan Commission voted 4-0 to recommend that the Village Board approve the petition associated with PC 18-01.

# AN ORDINANCE APPROVING A TEXT AMENDMENT TO THE LOMBARD ZONING ORDINANCE TITLE 15, CHAPTER 155, SECTION 155.602 OF THE LOMBARD ZONING CODE

PC 18-01: Text Amendments to the Zoning Ordinance

WHEREAS, the Village of Lombard maintains a Zoning Ordinance which is found in Title 15, Chapter 155 of the Lombard Code; and,

WHEREAS, the Board of Trustees deem it reasonable to periodically review said Zoning Ordinance and make necessary changes; and,

WHEREAS, a public hearing to consider text amendments to the Zoning Ordinance has been conducted by the Village of Lombard Plan Commission on January 22, 2018, pursuant to appropriate and legal notice; and,

WHEREAS, the Plan Commission has filed its recommendations with the President and Board of Trustees recommending approval of the text amendments described herein; and,

WHEREAS, the President and Board of Trustees approve and adopt the findings and recommendations of the Plan Commission and incorporate such findings and recommendations herein by reference as if they were fully set forth herein;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE PRESIDENT AND BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE VILLAGE OF LOMBARD, DU PAGE COUNTY, ILLINOIS, as follows:

**SECTION 1:** That Title 15, Chapter 155, Section 155.602 of the Lombard Village Code are hereby amended as follows:

§ 155.602 - Off-street parking.
