Amending Title 11, Chapter 112, Section 112.38(A) - Alcoholic Beverages

Solicitation of Alcohol Purchases

The last sentence of Title 11, Chapter 112, Section 112.38(A), Solicitation, of the Village Code states:

"Minors are prohibited from drawing, pouring, mixing and soliciting orders for any alcoholic liquor or beverage."

Staff received an inquiry from a liquor licensee, asking for the definition of the term "minors". Village Counsel researched the term "minors" and concluded that the term refers to an individual who is under 18 years of age, even in the context of alcoholic liquor regulations, and the current language of the last sentence of Section 112.38(A) of Village Code could be interpreted as implying that individuals who are at least 18 years of age, but under 21 years of age, can draw, pour, mix and solicit orders for any alcoholic liquor or beverage. In an effort to avoid an inaccurate interpretation of Village Code, Village Counsel drafted the attached ordinance clarifying the language in Section 112.38(A) in regard to the term "minors" by revising the last sentence to read:

"Except as provided in Section 112.33(B) of this Code, it shall be unlawful for anyone under the age of 21 years old to draw, pour, mix or solicit orders for any alcoholic liquor or beverage."

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING TITLE XI, CHAPTER 112, SECTION 112.38(A) OF THE LOMBARD VILLAGE CODE IN REGARD TO ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGES AND THE SERVICE THEREOF

BE IT ORDAINED by the President and Board of Trustees of the Village of Lombard, DuPage County, Illinois, as follows:

SECTION 1: That Title XI, Chapter 112, Section 112.38(A) of the Lombard Village Code is amended by revising the last sentence thereof to read in its entirety as follows:

"Except as provided in Section 112.33(B) of this Code, it shall be unlawful for anyone under the age of 21 years old to draw, pour, mix or solicit orders for any alcoholic liquor or beverage."

SECTION 2: That this Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage, approval and publication in pamphlet form, as provided by law.
