Dear President and Trustees:

Your Plan Commission transmits for your consideration its recommendation regarding the above-referenced petition. The petitioner, the Village of Lombard, requests text amendments to Sections 155.415 (C)(23), 155.416 (C)(23), 155.417 (G)(2)(b)(xi), and 155.418 (C)(18) of the Lombard Zoning Ordinance (and any other relevant sections for clarity) to amend the text for consistency regarding massage establishments and correct the reference sections regarding massage establishments.

After due notice and as required by law, the Plan Commission conducted a public hearing for this petition on July 16, 2018. Sworn in to present the petition was Jennifer Ganser, Assistant Director.

Chairperson Ryan read the Plan Commission procedures and asked if anyone other than the petitioner intended to cross examine and, hearing none, he proceeded with the petition.

Chairperson Ryan asked if any person would like to speak in favor or against this petition, or for public comment. Hearing none, he asked for the staff report.

Ms. Ganser presented the staff report, which was submitted to the public record in its entirety. The Village is requesting a text amendment to the zoning ordinance to emend the text for consistency regarding massage establishments and correct the reference sections regarding massage establishments. Staff still supports massage establishments as a conditional use in the B3, B4, B4A, and B5 Districts with the below text amendments

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AN ORDINANCE APPROVING A TEXT AMENDMENT TO THE LOMBARD ZONING ORDINANCE TITLE 15, CHAPTER 155, SECTIONS 155.415 (C)(23), 155.416 (C)(23), 155.417 (G)(2)(b)(xi), and 155.418 (C)(18) OF THE LOMBARD ZONING CODE

PC 18-20: Text Amendments to the Zoning Ordinance

WHEREAS, the Village of Lombard maintains a Zoning Ordinance which is found in Title 15, Chapter 155 of the Lombard Code; and,

WHEREAS, the Board of Trustees deem it reasonable to periodically review said Zoning Ordinance and make necessary changes; and,

WHEREAS, a public hearing to consider text amendments to the Zoning Ordinance has been conducted by the Village of Lombard Plan Commission on July 16, 2018, pursuant to appropriate and legal notice; and,

WHEREAS, the Plan Commission has filed its recommendations with the President and Board of Trustees recommending approval of the text amendments described herein; and,

WHEREAS, the President and Board of Trustees approve and adopt the findings and recommendations of the Plan Commission and incorporate such findings and recommendations herein by reference as if they were fully set forth herein;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE PRESIDENT AND BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE VILLAGE OF LOMBARD, DU PAGE COUNTY, ILLINOIS, as follows:

SECTION 1: That Title 15, Chapter 155, Sections 155.415 (C)(23), 155.416 (C)(23), 155.417 (G)(2)(b)(xi), and 155.418 (C)(18) of the Lombard Village Code are hereby amended as follows:

§ 155.415(C)(23) - B3 Community Shopping District requirements.

Physical culture and Massage establishments (as defined and regulated by Chapter 12 Title 11, section Chapter 122 of the Code of Ordinances)

§ 155.416(C)(23) - B4 Corridor Commercial District requirements.

Physical culture and Massage establishments (as defined and regulated by Chapter 12 Title 11, section Chapter 122 of the Code of Ordinances)

§ 155.417(G)(2)(b)(xi) - Roosevelt Road Corridor B4A District requirements. Therapeutic Massage establishments (as defined and regulated by Chapter 12 Title 11, section Chapter 122 of the Code of Ordinances)
§ 155.418(C)(18) - B5 Central Business District requirements. Physical culture and Massage establishments (as defined and regulated by Title 11, Chapter 122, of the Code of Ordinances)
