Text Amendments to the Village Code of Ordinances, Chapter 36, Section 36.22: Fee Waiver for Local Governments and

School Districts

As part of the Village's ongoing fiscal review of development regulations and policies, the Community Development Department identified the existing fee waiver provisions for units of local government and school districts. This matter was reviewed by the Board of Building Appeals (BOBA) as well as the Economic and Community Development Committee (ECDC). Both entities unanimously recommended approval of the elimination of the fee waiver provision for public hearing fees as well as building permit fees. The Board of Trustees approved this recommendation on June 21, 2018 for Chapter 14 and Section 150.141 as Ordinance 7555. However, another reference to fee waivers was found in Chapter 36 that was previously overlooked and in need of amending to be consistent with the intent of the past Village Board action.

Attached is an ordinance amending Chapter 36, Section 36.22 of the Village Code to eliminate the fee waiver provisions, with an effective date of January 1, 2019.

SECTION 1: That effective January 1, 2019, Title III, Chapter 36, Section 36.22 of the Lombard Village Code shall be amended to read in its entirety as follows:

§ 36.22 - Waiver.

The fees set forth in § 36.21 shall not be applicable to any governmental unit or to any charitable organization as defined in "An Act to Regulate Solicitation and Collection of Funds for Charitable Purposes, Providing for Violations Thereof and Making an Appropriation Therefor", 225 ILCS 460/1. Any other application may request waiver of any fees from the President and Board of Trustees who, upon demonstration of hardship caused by such fees, may waive such fees.

SECTION 2: That this Ordinance shall be in full force and effect after its passage, approval and publication in pamphlet form as provided by law.
